3. To discuss the value of parenting interventions to reduce unexplained physical symptoms.

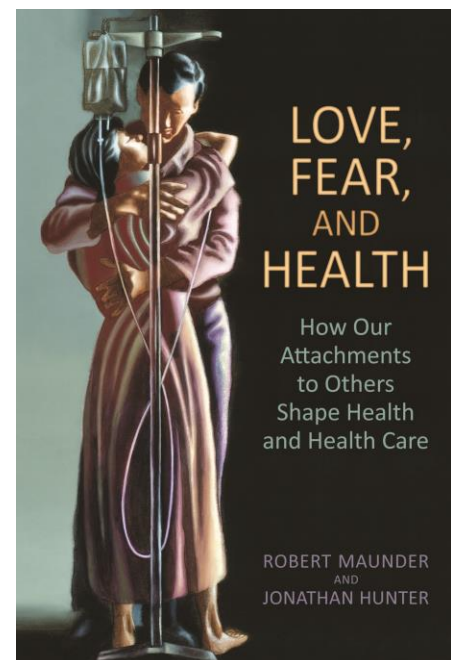
